Code of Conduct for Parents/Spectators

Parents/spectators have a great influence on children's enjoyment and success in football. All children play football because they first and foremost love the game – it's fun. It is important to remember that however good a child becomes at football it is important that they receive positive encouragement. This will contribute to:

- children enjoying football
- a sense of personal achievement
- self-esteem
- improvement in the child's skills and techniques.

Parent's/spectator's expectations and attitudes have a significant bearing on a child's attitude towards:

- other players
- officials
- managers
- spectators.

Parents/spectators within St Peters Iver FC should always be positive and encouraging towards all of the children, not just their own.

Parents/spectators should:

- applaud the opposition as well as your own team
- avoid coaching the child during the game
- not to shout and scream
- respect the referee's decision
- give attention to each of the children involved in football, not just the most talented
- give encouragement to everyone to participate in football.
